- 1 Submittal of a preliminary application.
- 2 Compliance with agency comments, if any.
- 3 It is strongly suggested that alternate access be dedicated, where possible, around all water bodies for other than winter access.
- 4 Place all applicable certificates on the plat.
- 5 Show dedication of trail within the NE 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 21, T16N, R4W, S.K. AK. (Sheet 4 of 8) if this was intended but overlooked.
- On Sheet 8 of 8, clarify the location of the trail in relationship to the cemetary.
- 7 Submittal of a final plat in full compliance with Title 16 including all the recommendations of the Engineering Dept.
- Bustify trail as shown affecting Sections 27 & 28, T16N, R4W, S.M. AK. is actual historic location of Iditarod Trail with copies of documentation supplied to the Borough and to Ben Cowart, 2260 Tasha, Anchorage, AK 99502.
