Iditarod Area School District Bethel-Lower Xicon School District  
P.O. Box 105 McGrath 99627)

Henry Bismark may have been last proprietor of this roadhouse - person. conv. w/ Tony Guarte  
(around 1917) 2/25/81 TO Sullivan

Tony Guarte remembers the roadhouse and both Joe Jean and Henry Bismark (sp?) as  
proprietors. Roadhouse was small as was a stopover for meals and drinks.  
Guarte thinks that foundation remains may still be there. (T.O. Sullivan 2/25/81)
