

**DESCRIPTION OF TATINA AVIATION FIELD RESERVE**

A piece or parcel of land situated in Latitude 65° 28' North, Longitude 152° 53' West, Fourth Judicial Division, Territory of Alaska, more particularly described as follows: From a stake at the point of land at the confluence of Uliua River and South Fork of Kuskokwim River thence Due South a distance of 740 feet to Corner No. 1 or point of beginning. Thence S 81° 00' E a distance of 300 feet from a stake midway on the east or front end of Corner Caribou Wood Log Cabin, thence S 62° 30' E a distance of 1775 feet to Cor. No. 2, thence N 85° 00' E a distance of 3400 feet to Cor. No. 3, thence S 8° 00' E a distance of 200 feet to Cor. No. 4, thence S 27° 00' W a distance of 1470 feet to Cor. No. 5, thence S 21° 30' W a distance of 200 feet to Cor. No. 6, thence N 85° 30' W a distance of 2000 feet to Cor. No. 7, thence S 85° 00' W a distance of 1750 feet to Cor. No. 8, thence N 2° 40' W a distance of 200 feet to Cor. No. 9, thence N 75° E a distance of 4417 feet to Cor. No. 10 thence N 24° 30' E a distance of 500 feet to Cor. No. 1 the place of beginning. Said piece or parcel of land lying within the above described 10 boundaries containing 147 Acres more or less, all of which is Public Domain.
