 - Knute Drange old miner at Spruce Creek had claim & profitable operation there. Dredge was moved from Solomon to Spruce Creek.
 - In tape, Pete gave name of Elim R.H. owners
 - the Nusekts (Isaac R.H.) were Pete's second wife family.
 - Pete mentions cabins at Hastings Cr.
