Old Woman Roadhouse is nationally significant because of its association with the Iditarod National Historic Trail. Old Woman Cabin served as a shelter cabin and WAMCATS maintenance cabin on the Kaltag Portage. Presently, there remains the ruins of a large dog barn, which is relatively intact (without roof), and the ruins of the original roadhouse cabin. The ruins of the roadhouse cabin are presently eroding into the Old Woman River and will be completely gone within the next two years.
