Isaac Point is significant because of its association with the Iditarod National Historic Trail. A reported cabin on the west side of Isaac's Point (per Peterson's map 1980) was searched for but was not located. The cabin was referred to on a 1908 Lowman Brothers' map. Ruin visible, 1980.
