A.E.C. Report of 1916 identifies as a "stable" Roadhouse on the Ruby to Takotna trail
- A.E.C. Report of 1923-24 identifies the purchase of a Carlson's R.H. (in the vicinity of Lewis R.H.) for use as a shelter cabin.
