These notes together with my blue-lines should take care of the oral history information. You might also skim the indexes for further details if you have a question on something. [Indexes are in the oral history file which I have left on Terry's desk.]

In case things get really crazy and you have very little time, here are the major facts from my tapes which you may not have:

Checkkut - John Bahntke's father ran a R.H. here, in existence prior to 1907. Also a shelter cabin there. After John's father left, R.H. used as a shelter cabin. See index

Cheruk (R.H.?) John Bahntke says old "Farmer Brown" lived near Spruce Cr., between Taylor Lagoon & Topokuk. May have been a R.H.

See indexes for other cabin/RH possibilities at Hastings Cr., Lee Cr., etc. Bahntke index is one you should look at.

Fischer RH in Ruby Still extant, see Charlie Carlo, interview

Safety RH See Maurice Maloney interview for dates. The original one (the one her father purchased was destroyed prior to 1913, the
