**HISTORIC SIGNIFICANCE**

Formerly a two-story log building with a high gable.  
Two one-story additions.  
~~28 miles from Robn River Roadhouse. Claus Anderson was owner in 1917. From roadhouse Anderson could see three to four miles down the trail to approaching travelers.~~  
Not mentioned by CADWALLANDER (1917) as Pass Creek RH, but probably Anderson's Rainy Pass RH, reported to be 29 miles from Robn River, 9 miles from Rainy Pass by CADWALLANDER - see 2106 (distances check)  
Probably Goodwin's 1908 reference to RH 29 miles from Happy River

**SITE IDENTIFICATION / CONDITION / INTEGRITY**

act location unknown (?) *→ Reed. See Reed, October 1965, 10.*  
Original structure was a two-story log building with a high gable.  
May be Goodwin's reference to roadhouse 29 miles north of Happy River (1908)  
Reed: a long ramshackle log building facing south with a big smoke pipe behind (1920) (photo)
