THE 2 STORY HOUSE MEASURE CA 6X9 M. WITH A TAR PAPER LEAN-TO OFF THE BACK THAT MEASURES CA 4X2M. THE HAND HEWN LOGS OF THE MAIN STRUCTURE HAVE BEEN COVERED WITH THIN PLYWOOD AND THE ROOF OF GALVANIZED METAL IS RECENT. THE HOUSE HAS BEEN EMPTY FOR 2 YRS. IT IS IN DANGER OF DESTRUCTION BY FLOODING OF THE UNALAKLEET R. BUILT BY MARY'S FATHER, OLE OLSEN BAHR, IN 1906, THIS IS THE ONLY CABIN RELATED TO THE LAPLANDERS ACTIVITIES IN 1898. 100 LAP-LANDERS
5. SIGNIFICANCE WERE BROUGHT TO HERD REINDEER. THEY HERDED PROFITABLY UNTIL 1940 WHEN ONLY ESKIMOS WERE PERMITTED TO HERD REINDEER.
