D. PLANNING

1. Master Plan

The station currently operates in accordance with the Innoko National Wildlife Refuge Comprehensive Conservation Plan (CCP). This document was developed pursuant to Sections 304(g), 1008, and 1317 of the Alaska National Interest Lands Conservation Act of 1980 (Alaska Lands Act), Section 3(d) of the Wilderness Act of 1964, and Section 102(2)(C) of the National Environmental Policy Act of 1969 (NEPA). The plan, in final form, was approved in October of 1987 and includes an environmental impact statement and wilderness review. This document forms the foundation for all "step-down" management plans.

2. Management Plans

At the time of this report, the station has two management plans approved in final form: the Innoko NWR Fisheries Management Plan dated 3/93; and the Innoko NWR Environmental Education Plan dated 9/93. Other management plans are in various stages of development. A Draft Innoko NWR Fire Management Plan was completed this year and significant progress was made relative to the station's Wildlife Inventory/Habitat Assessment Plan and Facilities Management Plan.
