### **4A.1 INTRODUCTION**

[Note: An outline of the Construction Unanticipated Discoveries Plan for cultural resources encountered during construction is provided in Appendix 4A and will be updated in the the final report.]

The Alaska Pipeline Project (APP) has developed this plan to establish procedures to be used in the event that previously unreported and unanticipated cultural resources or human remains are found during construction of APP. The procedures differ depending on whether unanticipated non-human cultural remains or human remains are encountered as well as whether unanticipated cultural materials are found on federal, state, or private lands<sup>11</sup>.

Prior to the commencement of work in the field, APP and contractor personnel will receive environmental training. Environmental training will include guidance on identifying potential cultural materials and human remains.
