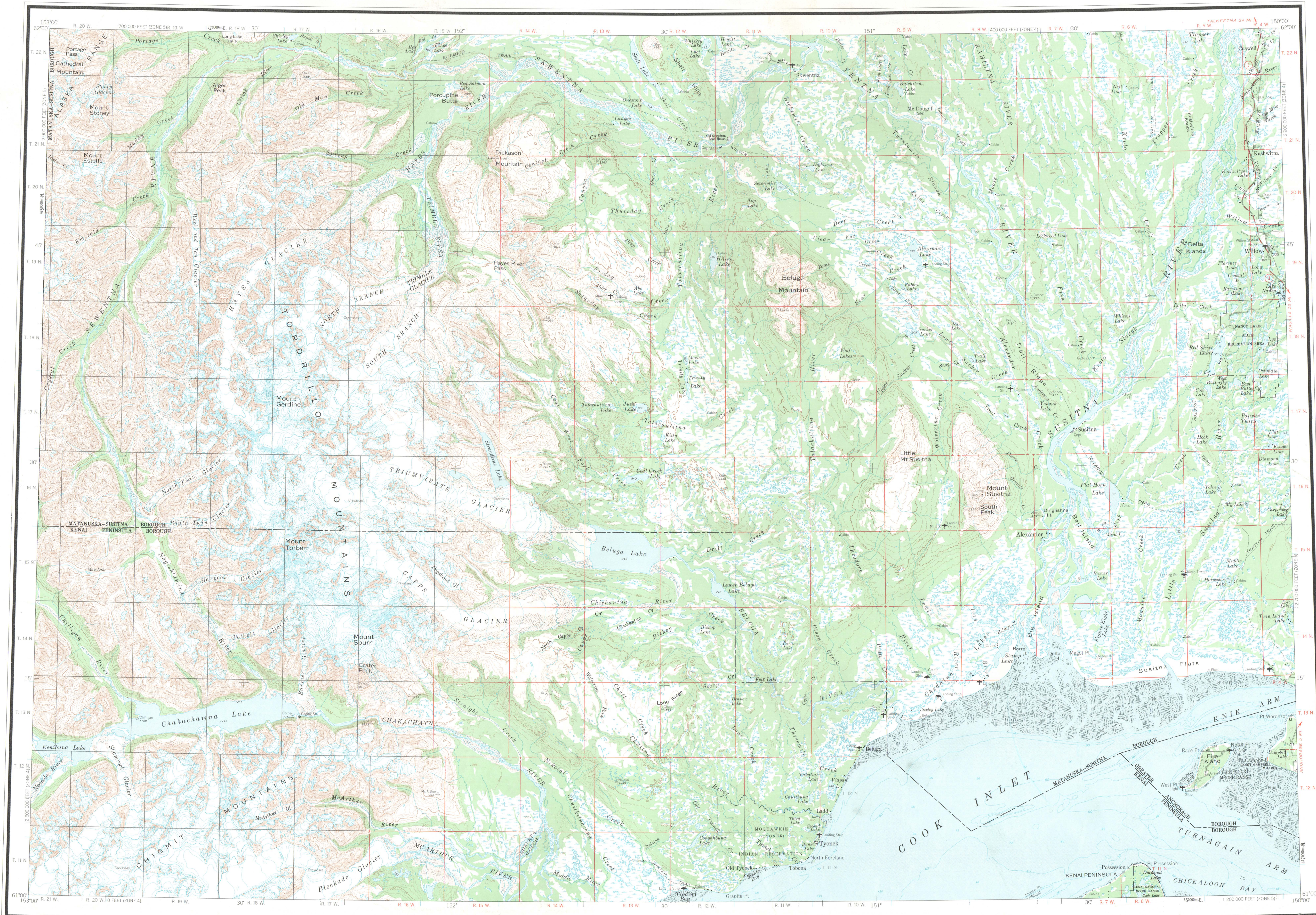

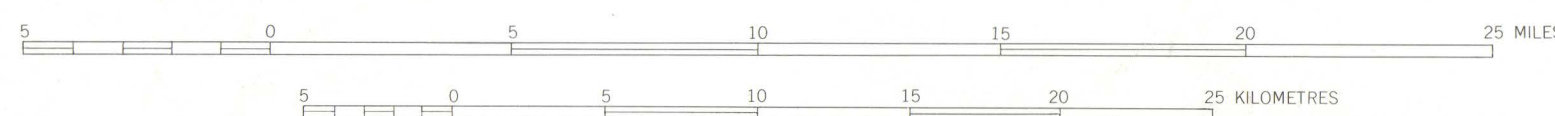
UNIVERSAL TRANSVERSE MERCATOR PROJECTION, 1927 NORTH AMERICAN DATUM

FOLIOS S-2, S-3, S-12 AND S-13, SEWARD MERIDIAN

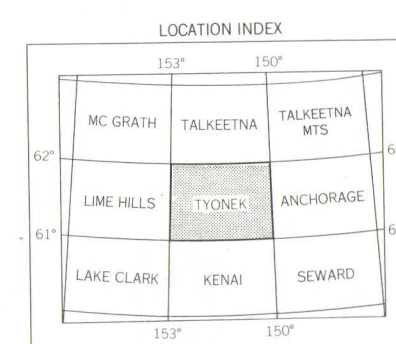
