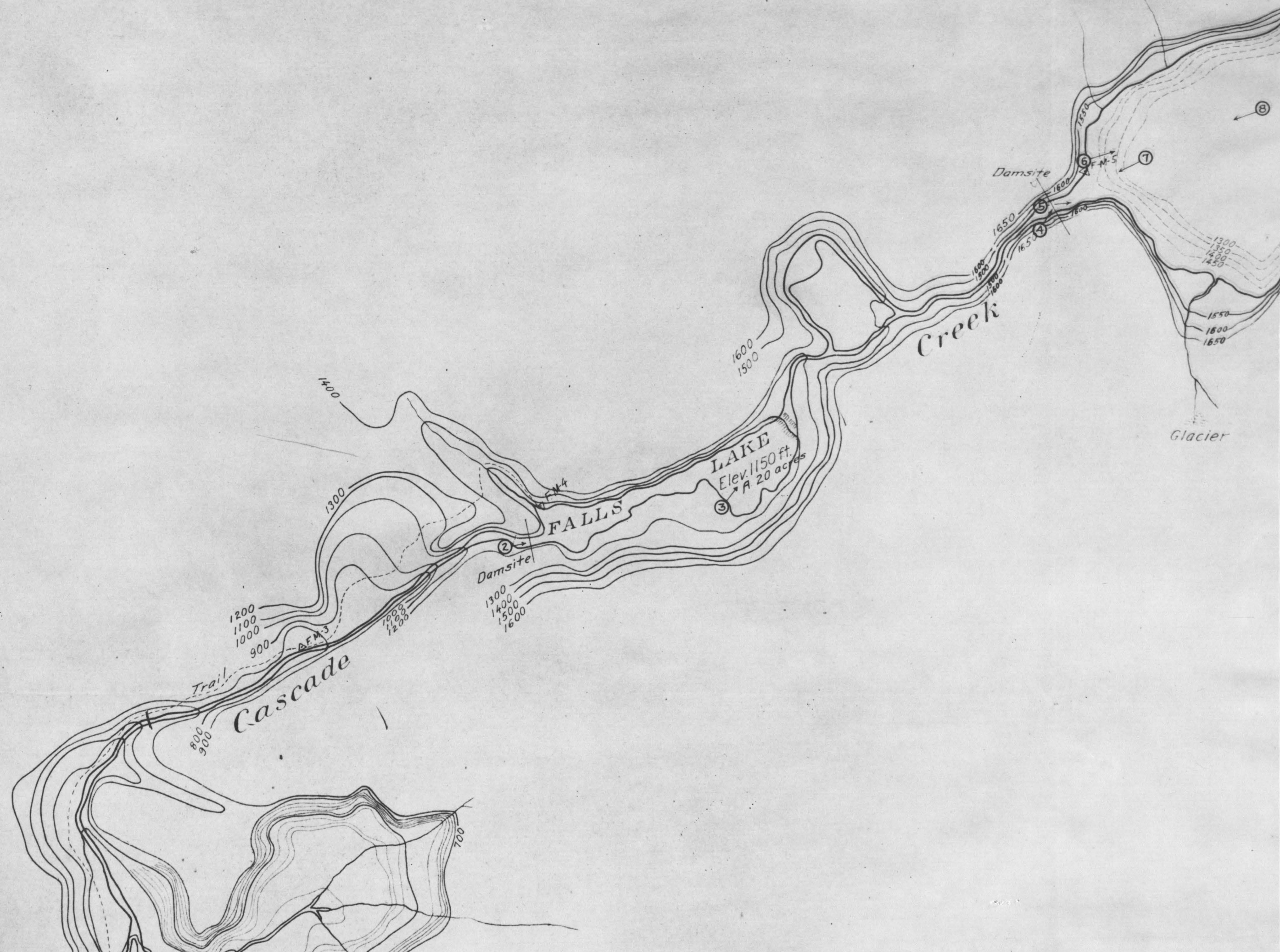
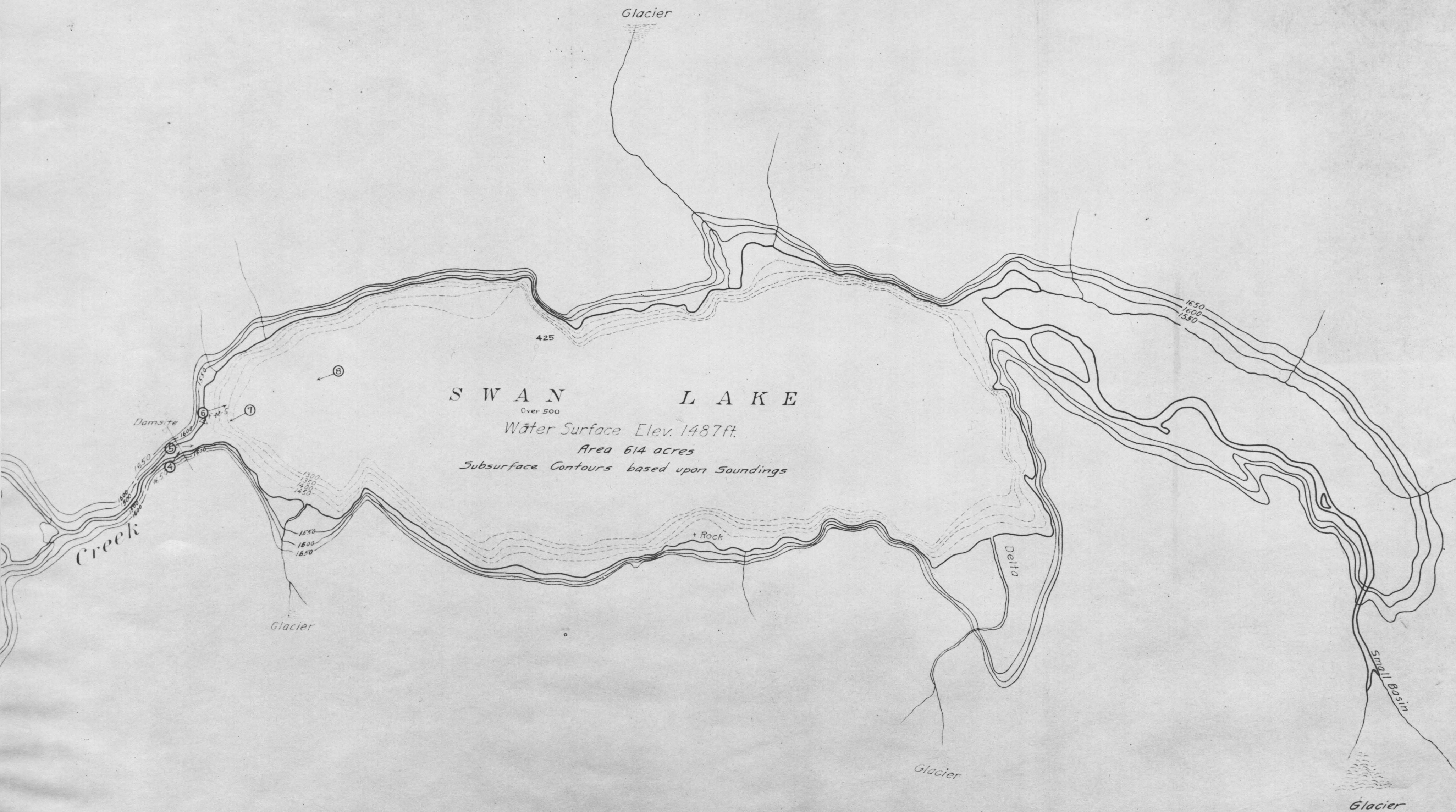




LOCALITY MAP
