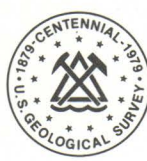
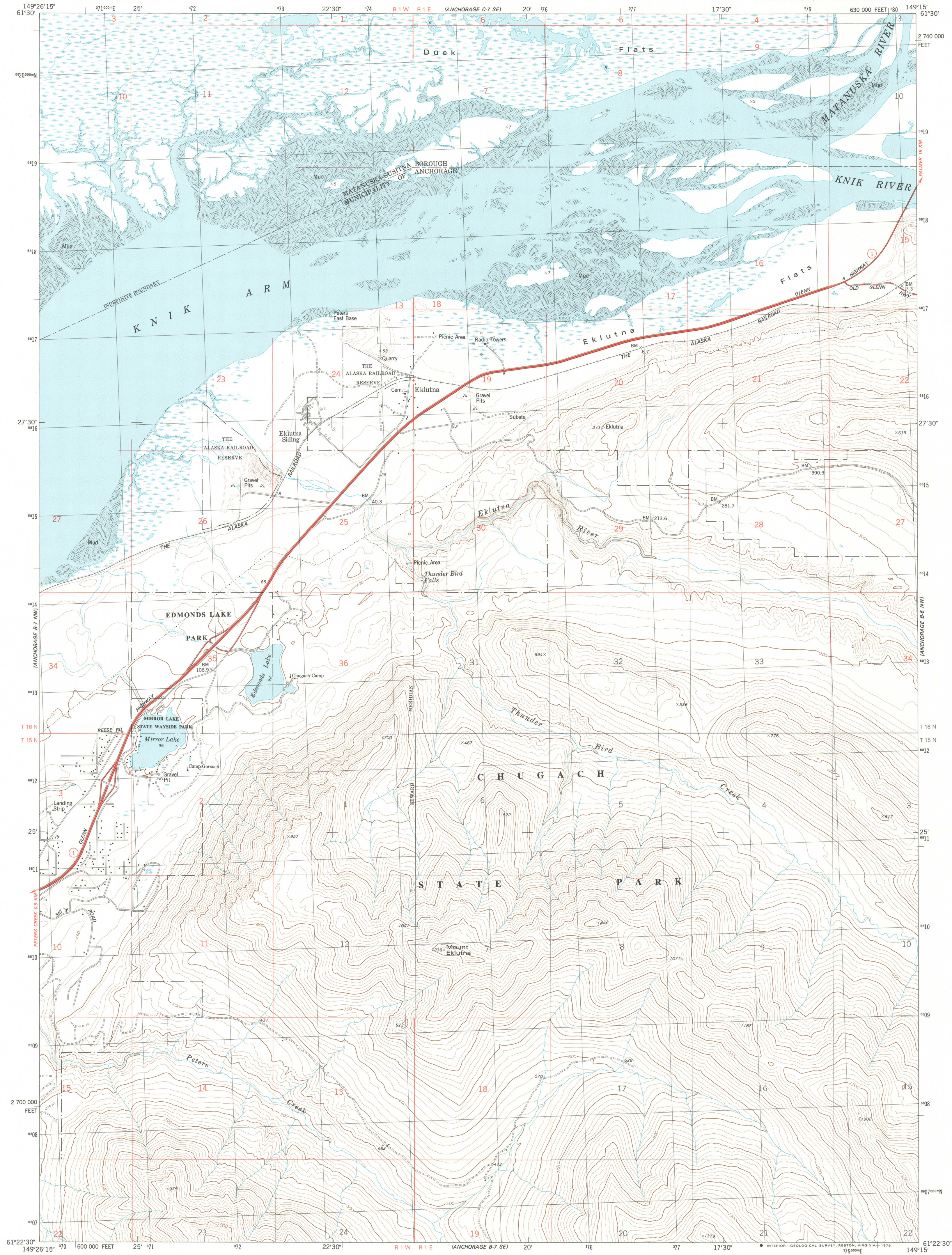

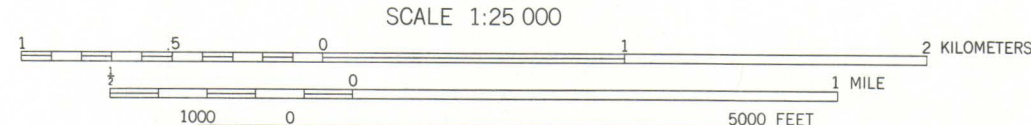
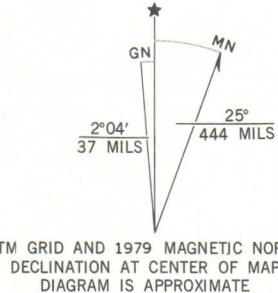


ANCHORAGE (B-7) NE QUADRANGLE
