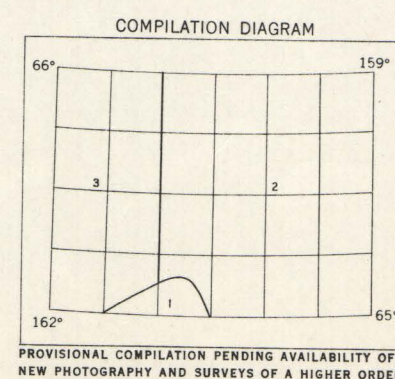

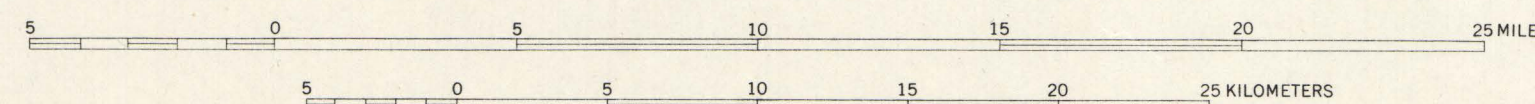
UNIVERSAL TRANSVERSE MERCATOR PROJECTION, ZONE 5

TO TRIMETROGRAPH BASE

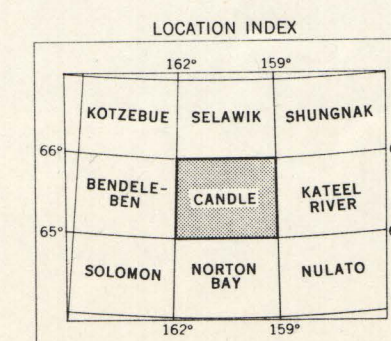
