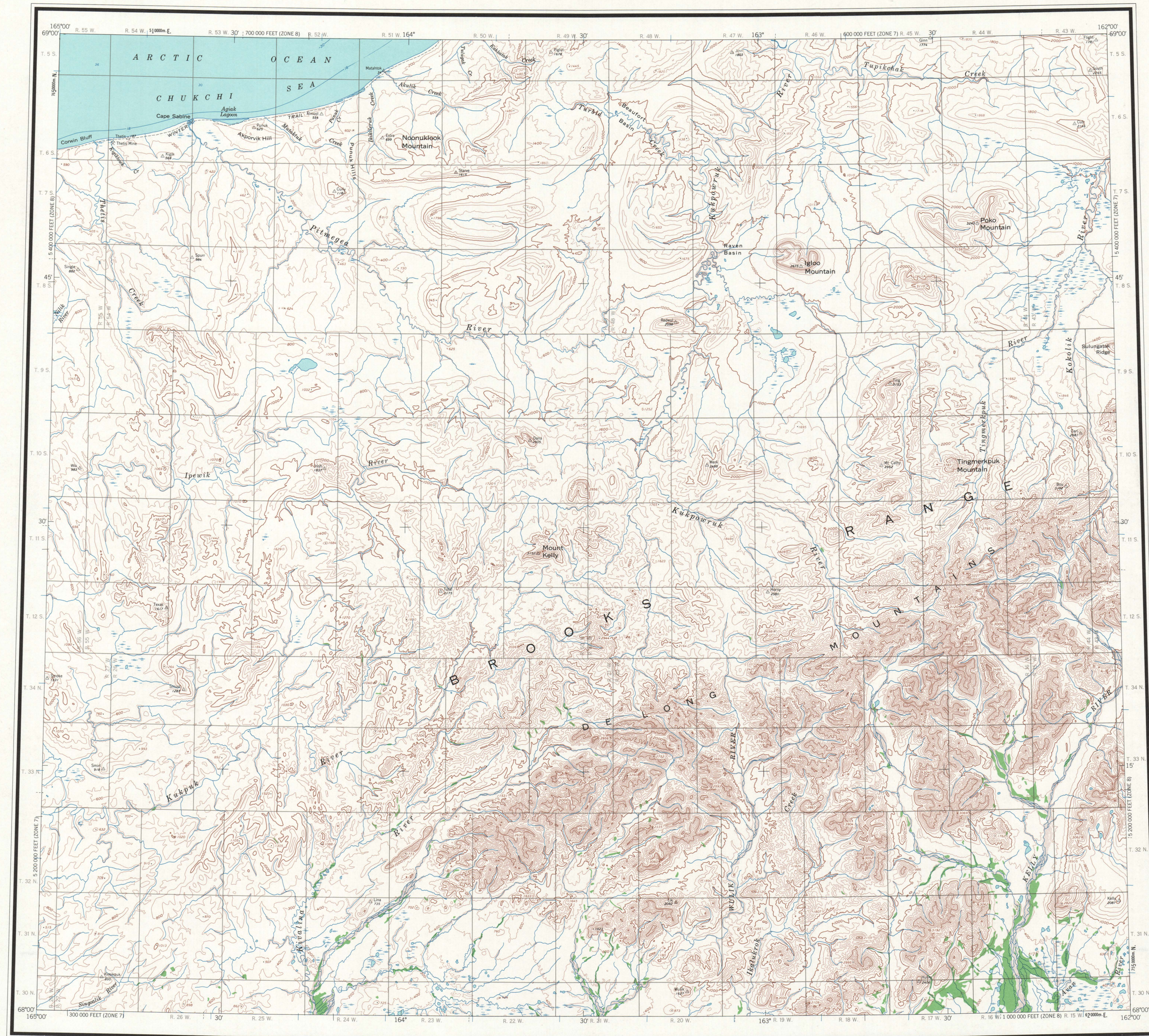

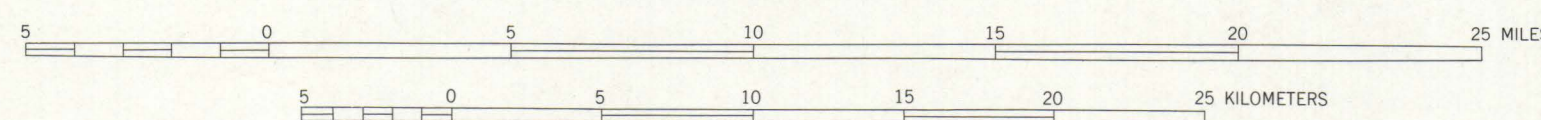

ZONE 3, SHOWN IN BLUE

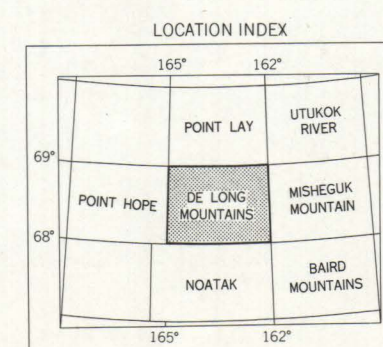
