It was very difficult to support a family or get ahead in life.

Things changed when the Donlin Creek project started. Good employment began to be available: I and many others in our area were able to get steady well paid jobs. I was able to buy my own house and pay for it. I was able to provide neccesities for my children and pay for travel for medical and educational needs.

Many households in our economically deprived area were finally able to purchase the means to better utilize the subsistence resources upon which they have always depended.

The quality of life has improved greatly in our area because of mining development.

I have attended many informational presentations about mining and the methods used in modern mining.
