(On record - 3:19 p.m.)

MS. McCAMMON: We do need a Federal Chair.

MS. D. WILLIAMS: I think Jim Wolfe is up.

MS. McCAMMON: Jim Wolfe, okay. You're on, Jim, and you don't have an agenda before you but I can tell you

what's on.

CHAIRMAN WOLFE: Okay. We do have a quorum on board. Is this being recorded or anything?

MS. McCAMMON: Yes, it is and you should probably go through all the names.

CHAIRMAN WOLFE: Okay. It sounds like we have Jim Balsiger for NOAA/National Marine Fisheries; we have Craig Tillery for Department of Law; Frank Rue for Fish and Game; Michele Brown for DEC; Deborah Williams for Department of Interior; and myself, Jim Wolfe, for Department of Agriculture/Forest Service.

So I guess we are now officially ready to move ahead.

We don't have an agenda, but at this point you're going to read
the agenda to us, are you, Molly?

MS. McCAMMON: Yes, we have a lot of noise on our line, but there's one item on the agenda today and that is.....

(Dial tone on phone)

CHAIRMAN WOLFE: Did we loose somebody?

MS. McCAMMON: We better check. 1 CHAIRMAN WOLFE: How about Jim Balsiger? 2 MR. BALSIGER: I'm still here. 3 CHAIRMAN WOLFE: Okay. Deborah? 4 MS. D. WILLIAMS: Here. 5 CHAIRMAN WOLFE: Frank? 6 MR. RUE: Yes, I'm here. 7 CHAIRMAN WOLFE: Michele? 8 MS. BROWN: I'm here. 9 MS. McCAMMON: Craig. 10 CHAIRMAN WOLFE: Craiq? 11 MR. TILLERY: I'm here. 12 MS. McCAMMON: Barry and Gina? 13 MR. ROTH: Yes. 14 MS. BELT: (No response) 15 MS. McCAMMON: Gina? 16 CHAIRMAN WOLFE: All right. 17 18 MS. McCAMMON: Well, I think we may have lost Gina. Okay, she'll call in. 19 20 But I think you all should have gotten a copy of the resolution that was sent around and it's a motion to basically 21 22 get permission to go to the court for money for certain land 23 acquisitions prior to execution of purchase agreements. Does

everyone have a copy of the draft resolution?

MR. BALSIGER: Yes.

MS. BROWN: Yes.

MR. RUE: Yes.

MS. McCAMMON: Okay. I could go through it for you, Jim.

CHAIRMAN WOLFE: Someone would need to go through it briefly, I would think, yeah.

MS. McCAMMON: Okay. Typically in land acquisitions Department of Law and Department of Justice go to court for the money once a purchase agreement is executed.

Because on a couple of acquisition we're virtually doing the purchase agreements and the closings almost on the same day, if not with just a few days in between. And also because we're trying to minimize the number of court requests that we have while Gina Belt is on leave.

For this reason the request is for certain select acquisitions to get permission to go to the court to obtain funding prior to execution of the purchase agreements. And those parcels are a couple of small parcels, KAP-220, KAP-226 and KENAI-1034, and then also for the Afognak Joint Venture acquisition.

The motion that's being proposed to you is to amend the resolutions that reference those acquisitions to permit the withdrawal of funds prior to the execution of the purchase agreements, subject to a number of conditions. And I should mention here that these conditions and this draft have been

reviewed by all of the State and Federal attorneys and the version that you have in front of you reflects their changes.

MS. D. WILLIAMS: Okay. Mr. Chairman.

CHAIRMAN WOLFE: Deborah, yes.

MS. D. WILLIAMS: I move to adopt the resolution as described by Ms. McCammon and in front of us.

CHAIRMAN WOLFE: Do we have a second?

MS. BROWN: Second. This is Michele.

CHAIRMAN WOLFE: Okay. We have a second from

Michele Brown. Any discussion?

(No audible responses)

CHAIRMAN WOLFE: I have one question while people are thinking about it and it's only because we have two different versions here. And Item B, under the conditions in one version say, the governments and the Executive Director, and the other one says the United States Department of Interior, the State of Alaska and the Executive Director must certify prior to closing. Which is the final?

MR. SWIDERSKI: The one that says the United -- this is Alex Swiderski, Mr. Chairman. The one that says United States Department of Interior.

CHAIRMAN WOLFE: Okay. Very good. Any other comments?

(No audible responses)

CHAIRMAN WOLFE: Okay. Well, shall we have a

vote. All in favor?

IN UNISON: Aye.

CHAIRMAN WOLFE: Anybody opposed?

(No opposing responses)

CHAIRMAN WOLFE: Well, sounds like we have a resolution or a motion and a resolution. And you will get that around for everybody's signature in short order, I assume.

MS. McCAMMON: Yes, we will.

CHAIRMAN WOLFE: All right. Any other

business?

MR. TILLERY: Mr. Chairman.

CHAIRMAN WOLFE: Yes, Mr. Tillery.

MR. TILLERY: Just to report something. Gina Belt and -- this is Craig Tillery. Gina Belt and I met with the clerk of court yesterday to go over our proposal for how to do electronic fund transfers. The court essentially concurred with them and both the Department of Justice and Department of Law today filed a motion with the court to amend the transfer of proceeds order to allow for the electronic transfer. We hope and anticipate that that will be signed pretty expeditiously and we hope that when we do go to the court for the next disbursement for these parcels that we will be using electronic transfer.

CHAIRMAN WOLFE: That's good news.

MR. ROTH: The effect of which is we're

implementing one of the GAO recommendations. 1 MR. TILLERY: And also, for example, in this 2 particular thing, it'll save us at least \$15,000 for this 3 particular disbursement. MS. D. WILLIAMS: Good. 5 CHAIRMAN WOLFE: Good is right. 6 7 MS. D. WILLIAMS: So there must be a piece of land we want to buy. CHAIRMAN WOLFE: Any other business? 9 10 (No audible responses) CHAIRMAN WOLFE: Well, do I hear a motion to 11 12 recess then? MR. BALSIGER: I move we recess. 13 14 MS. McCAMMON: Until October 27th in Juneau. MR. BALSIGER: Thank you, I was going to add 15 16 that. MR. RUE: Seconded. 17 18 CHAIRMAN WOLFE: Okay. I guess we have a 19 motion and a second to -- did we say recess or to..... 20 MR. RUE: Recess. 21 MS. BROWN: You said recess. 22 MR. TILLERY: You mistakenly said recess and that's the motion. 23 MR. RUE: And it's been seconded. 24 25 MS. BROWN: And there can't be a friendly
