8 administrative	budget for January and February.
9	And can we take a roll call just to confirm
10 all the Trustee	e Council members?
11	MS. WOMAC: I think so.
12	CHAIRMAN FREDIKSSON: Okay. Gail, maybe if
13 you or your sta	aff would just yell us off and we would note
14 by stating here	2.
15	MS. WOMAC: Drue.
16	MS. PEARCE: Hello. I'm sorry I was
17 answering a que	estion.
18	MR. MEADE: You're supposed to say here.
19	MS. PEARCE: I'm here.
20	MS. WOMAC: Drue, Kurt.
21	CHAIRMAN FREDIKSSON: Here.
22	MS. WOMAC: Scott.
23	MR. NORDSTRAND: Here.
24	MS. WOMAC: Joe.
25	MR. MEADE: Here.

12 Gail, you have provided all the members a copy of a
13 resolution for the EVOS administrative budget for the next
14 two months and an Attachment A, Summary of Expenses. I
15 believe there were some just last minute just minor
16 modifications to that. I would ask that you just kind of
17 walk us through those documents so that we're all on the
18 same sheet of music.
19 MS. PHILLIPS: Sure. The first page, the
20 personnel cost stay virtually the same. On the second
21 page, under travel, we added 14,000 for Trustee Council
22 travel, which is broken down on the third page, the fund
23 distribution to the agencies. You'll see how it's broken
24 down into each agency. We added also the \$2,000 for the
25 symposium speakers and the \$9,425 for the PAC meeting

1 expenses in January.

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2	The other two major additions were under
3	contractual we added the amount of the IGD report requested
4	that we do to create a habitat catalogue. DNR wants to get
5	started on that right away, so we put the money in this
6	budget. And then the other major amount of money,
7	different from the December budget is the \$25,000 for the
8	symposium.
9	CHAIRMAN FREDIKSSON: Okay. Thank you,
10	Gail. Are there any questions from the Council members
11	regarding any of the itemized expenses here?
12	(No audible response)
13	CHAIRMAN FREDIKSSON: Gail, this is Kurt,
14	if I might jump in with one question. We had these for
15	example, I know you and your staff and others have been
16	working on the symposium agenda, and I know it's been
17	they're trying to, you know, nail this down, but it's still
18	somewhat fluid, understandably, it's a month and half away.
19	We have the symposium speaker cost there at 2,000; is that
20	still subject to some change? If we were to change that I
21	would just want to know that we're not going to go over
22	that, but if possible that could even go lower?
23	MS. PHILLIPS: Right now I think the cost
24	will be somewhere in the range of 1,700 to 2,000, so it
25	could go a couple of hundred dollars lower.

1 CHAIRMAN FREDIKSSON: Okay. Are there any other questions from the Council members? 2 3 MR. O'CONNOR: This is O'Connor, I don't think I have any. 4 5 MS. PEARCE: This is Drue, I don't have 6 any. 7 MR. MEADE: This is Joe and I don't have 8 any either. 9 MR. NORDSTRAND: Scott doesn't have any. 10 MR. CAMPBELL: I was going to let my 11 silence speak for itself but, no, I don't have any either. CHAIRMAN FREDIKSSON: Okay. Then I believe 12 13 we have a resolution that Gail has provided us. Would I 14 hear a motion? 15 MR. O'CONNOR: I move adoption of the 16 resolution. 17 MR. NORDSTRAND: Second by Nordstrand. 18 CHAIRMAN FREDIKSSON: Okay. We got the 19 resolution moved by Craig and seconded by Scott, are there 20 any comments or discussion? 21 MR. O'CONNOR: Call for the question on it. 22 CHAIRMAN FREDIKSSON: And perhaps we could, 23 Gail, since the question has been asked, if we could just 24 kind of do a roll call vote on this. 25 MS. PHILLIPS: Yes.

week, I'll head those your way then. 1 MS. PHILLIPS: Okay, great, thanks. 2 MR. O'CONNOR: I'm not sure I have the 3 4 whole list. I've got 06-05, 06-07.... MS. PHILLIPS: And this will be 06-06. 5 MR. O'CONNOR: And this will be 06-06. 6 7 MS. PHILLIPS: Right. 8 MR. O'CONNOR: And 06-04 we already did, 9 right? MS. PHILLIPS: Right. 10 CHAIRMAN FREDIKSSON: And, Gail, I know 11 12 you've been working on the February schedule, and as 13 always, no easy task, but I trust that's moving along. MS. PHILLIPS: Right, we have confirmed for 1415 February 8th at 10:00 a.m. 16 CHAIRMAN FREDIKSSON: Okay. Good, thank 17 you. Okay. Hearing nothing else on the agenda, 18 19 do we have a motion to adjourn? 20 MR. NORDSTRAND: Yes. MR. O'CONNOR: Second 21 CHAIRMAN FREDIKSSON: Any objection? 22 23 DR. GERSTER: Before we adjourn, this is 24 Dr. John Gerster, and we have a PAC meeting on the 26th 25 following the Marine Sciences Symposium and any Trustees

1 who will be in town are encouraged to attend.

2 CHAIRMAN FREDIKSSON: Thank you very much, 3 John. MR. MEADE: And, John, just so you know, I 4 5 would personally like to be able to attend, but I am out of 6 state that week, so I'm not going to be able to attend the 7 symposium or participate the PAC interaction, wish I could, but schedule won't permit. 8 9 DR. MEADE: That's why we have Steve Zemke, 11 12 he's just a taller clone. 13 CHAIRMAN FREDIKSSON: John, this is Kurt, I 14 am going to try and attend the symposium and would 15 definitely make the effort to join in on the PAC meeting. 16 DR. GERSTER: Thank you very much. 17 MR. O'CONNOR: This is Craig O'Connor, I 18 intend the same. 19 DR. GERSTER: Thank you, Craig. 20 MR.
