## HORNED PUFFIN

(*Fratercula corniculata*)

Horned puffins stand 14 to 15 inches tall, and since both sexes look alike, it's hard to tell which is male or female in this nesting pair. Puffins are pelagic birds spending most of their time at sea, except for summertime, when they lay a single egg within a seacliff burrow. These birds are excellent divers and use their wings above and below water to navigate in search of small fish. Horned puffins have a stiff, black, fleshy horn above each eye and an orange triangular bill with a red tip. This North Pacific counterpart to the penguin can be seen in Alaska, Canada, and at sea off the coasts of Washington, Oregon, and California.
