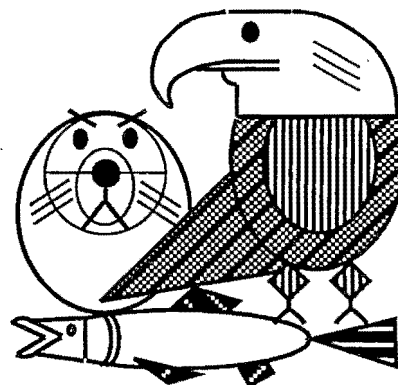

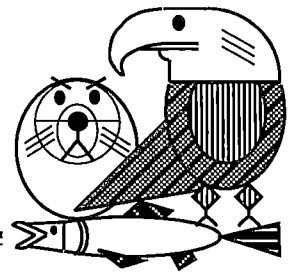

### Exxon Valdez Oil Spill Forum Five Years Later: What have we learned?

**Anchorage** - The Exxon Valdez Oil Spill Trustee Council is sponsoring a free, public, half-day forum to update the public on the recovery of natural resources injured by the March 1989 Exxon Valdez oil spill. The forum will take place on March 22, 1994, from 1:00 – 5:00 P.M. at the Regal Alaskan Hotel, Anchorage.

Scientists who have been studying the effects of the spill will present brief overviews on subjects ranging from the current status of birds, fish, marine mammals, subsistence resources, archaeological sites, the nearshore ecosystem and other subjects.

Presenters include Steve Pennoyer, Trustee and Alaska Regional Director, National Marine Fisheries Service; Dr. Robert Spies, Chief Scientist for the Trustee Council; Dr. Charles Peterson, Institute of Marine Sciences, University of North Carolina; and Charles Meacham, Deputy Commissioner, Alaska Department of Fish and Game.

The keynote speaker will be Dr. George Rose, Research Scientist for the Canadian Department of Fisheries and Oceans and Scientific Program Leader, Ocean Production Enhancement Network, St. John's, Newfoundland.

Maps, photos, computer programs and other updated information about restoration of the Exxon Valdez oil spill will be on display. There will be a social hour and opportunity to meet the scientists from 5:30 to 7:00 P.M.
