

### Exxon Valdez Oil Spill Forum Five Years Later: What have we learned?

**Anchorage -** The *Exxon Valdez* Oil Spill Trustee Council is sponsoring a free, public, half-day forum to update the public on the recovery of natural resources injured by the March 1989 Exxon Valdez oil spill.
