## **Brief Summary and Statement of Need:**

This project will provide partial funding to construct the Cordova Community Center. As part of the legacy of the Exxon Valdez Oil Spill (EVOS), a need exists for a facility that will serve several important EVOS administrative functions as the current EVOS Trustee Council office in Anchorage is phased out. The Cordova Center will provide an important centralized permanent facility for EVOS-related administrative functions, education, and events. The federal and state EVOS trustee council has approved this project.
