



I, R. Carl Clark, being duly sworn upon oath hereby depose and testify as follows:

1. I am a paralegal employed by the firm of Bogle & Gates which represents Exxon Shipping Company in this litigation.

2. I have personal knowledge of the facts contained in this affidavit.

3. On February 28, 1990, the parties exchanged witness identification on document identification interrogatories. Plaintiffs served upon Exxon Corporation, Exxon Shipping Company and Exxon Pipeline Company ("defendants") a set of document identification and witness identification interrogatories which contained 253 separate interrogatories. Each of the defendants have responded to these witness identification interrogatories and have identified a total of 1,647 individuals. Most of the private plaintiffs have refused to identify any potential witnesses in response to defendants' interrogatories. As a result, defendants have been forced to move to compel interrogatory answers by the private plaintiffs. Defendants' motion is pending before the Discovery Master.

4. On May 29, 1990, the plaintiffs served upon the defendants a set of Requests for Admission that contained 468 separate requests. Each of the defendants have responded to these requests.

5. On June 8, 1990, the plaintiffs and defendants exchanged requests for production of documents. Plaintiffs' requests for production of documents directed at the defendants contained 364 separate requests. All parties were to begin producing documents on October 1, 1990. The State of Alaska and the defendants began producing documents. To date, Exxon Corporation and Exxon Shipping Company have produced over 700,000 pages of documents.

6. Most private plaintiffs have failed to produce any documents. See the attached list of private plaintiffs who have failed to produced documents. Out of approximately 680 private plaintiffs, only approximately 20 have produced any documents. The total production by the private plaintiffs is less than 41,000 pages.

7. On November 30, 1990, without the agreement of the Exxon defendants or the deponents, the plaintiffs issued subpoenas and noticed the following depositions:

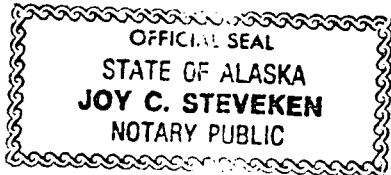

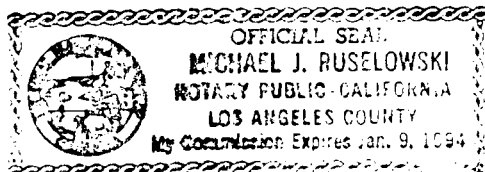
