Recovery from Environmental Disturbances

Attached for your advanced planning is a draft agenda for the November 5-6, 1991 Program Review. Thank you for agreeing to come to Anchorage. Attending the Program Review will be the Restoration Planning Work Group (RPWG) and Management Team, as well as Damage Assessment Principal Investigators and peer reviewers. Please note that the subject meeting will be held at the Simpson Building, 645 G Street.

The Program Review will be as informal as possible, and we hope that you will come prepared to share your insights on the recovery of disturbed ecosystems. We are asking that each of you prepare a 45-60 minute summary of your progress to date. An additional 30 minutes or longer will be allowed for questions and discussion. Of particular interest to RPWG will be information that you have found on:

- rate, duration and degree of recovery following disturbance,
- dependency of recovery on habitat protection, changes in management practices, and other restoration approaches.
- 3) indicators of recovery that are the most practical and cost effective to measure, and
- 4) approaches/strategies for how these indicators are best monitored/tested to determine when recovery has occurred.

Although dependent upon individual start-up dates, we are also expecting that most of you will submit five copies of your draft final report prior to the time of our meeting.



We have reserved a conference room that easily accommodates 25-30 people, and both overhead and 35 mm slide projectors are available.
