MEMORANDUM

RE: Restoration Planning/Litigation Products

Please find enclosed a list of major tasks and very crude timetable for a possible restitution/restoration case. This reflects a discussion among Sandy Rabinowitch, Ken Rice, and me on 19 September. I have massaged things further since then, so neither Sandy or Ken can be blamed for what is presented here.

The task headings in the attached list correspond to the headings in Attachment A of the RPWG memorandum dated 19 August. This is the draft outline for a Species- or Resource-Specific Summary Product, which was part of the conceptual materials we circulated in regard to a possible restitution/restoration case.

We very quickly need to reach agreement among RPWG and the Legal Team members on what we are going to produce for January. Please review this list of tasks in relation to the outline and give me your comments. You will see quickly that there is a great deal of overlap in the dates for completing various tasks. This is a real problem, given our resources. My own opinion is that our greatest weaknesses are our ability to produce the mapping products and cost estimations. Other tasks seems potentially in reach, although not in great detail. This all needs hard, realistic analysis of what is needed and what is possible.

The RPWG is tentatively planning a meeting on Thursday, 3 October. I propose a two-day meeting, with one day on RPWG business (e.g., need for economic analyses) and one day on restitution business. Bart and David, can you join us on either Wednesday and Thursday, 2-3 October, or Thursday and Friday, 3-4 October? The primary purpose of inviting Bart and David would be to bring to a closure the issue of what RPWG reasonably can prepare in the context of a restitution hearing.

Please let me know ASAP about your schedules.
