Dear Working Group:

This letter refers to the August 1990 Progress Report, "Restoration Planning Following the Exxon Valdez Oil Spill." I refer especially to page six, "Definition of Restoration."

I realize that the definitions are given in the law. Nonetheless, they contain at least one logical flaw and since that particular flaw, which I wish to discuss here, affects the success of recovery efforts, it is well that the flaw be widely understood. To compensate for the flaw, different values could be attached to the three "restoration" actions: 1) direct restoration, 2) replacement, 3) acquisition of equivalent resources.

The third "restoration" action, acquisition of equivalent resources, is the one I wish to address. This would be a logical restoration action if several to many assumptions are met. One would be that there is an infinte supply of the equivalent resources. This is obvioulsy not a valid assumption. Another might be, "if you are practical;" there is more of the equivalent resource than the world needs. That implies a value judgment that cannot be supported by fact. In light of our increasing recognition of the global impacts of local events and of Gaia related events, such an assumption is highly suspect.

In sum, acquisition of equivalent resources does nothing to restore. All it does is, hopefully, reduce the rate of loss of those resources elsewhere in the future. That is useful, but it only slows the downward conservation spiral and it is not restoration. It's time to stop pretending that it is.

Therefore, I suggest that for the purpose of deciding an appropriate action, multipliers be given to the three "restoration" actions. I further suggest that acquisition of eqivalent resources be given a multiplier apperoaching zero.

The argument against this develops when almost nothing can be done to help "nature" restore the oil affected areas and organisms anyhow, so in the long run we will save more by using the money to protect other areas against similar insults. If that proves to be true, a depressing but real possibility, then I would agree; but it certainly could not be restoration and it should not be advertised as restoration to the public.

As a final comment, the multiplier for replacement should be smaller than that for direct restoration: you do replacement if direct restoration won't work or is extremely expensive.

I realize that I may be saying things you already know, but I hope the suggestion for the use of multipliers will open a way to stay within the law while doing a better job of real restoration.

Thank you for the opportunity for imput and my congratulations for the way you have been seeking and interpreting public comment.




