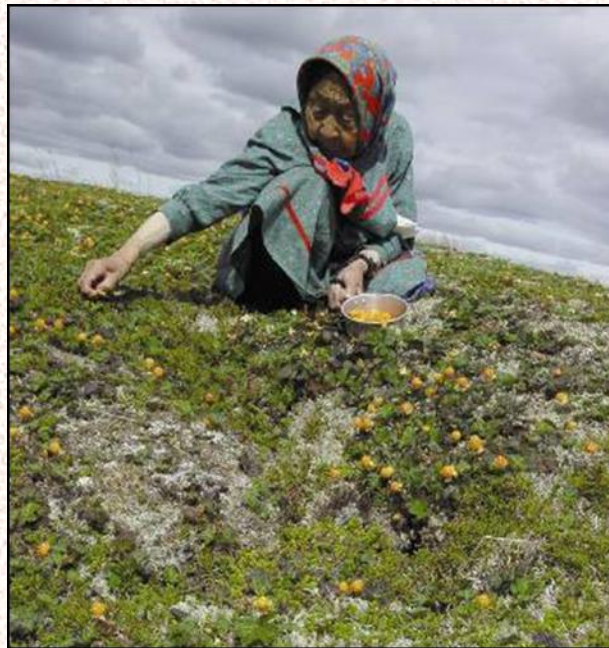


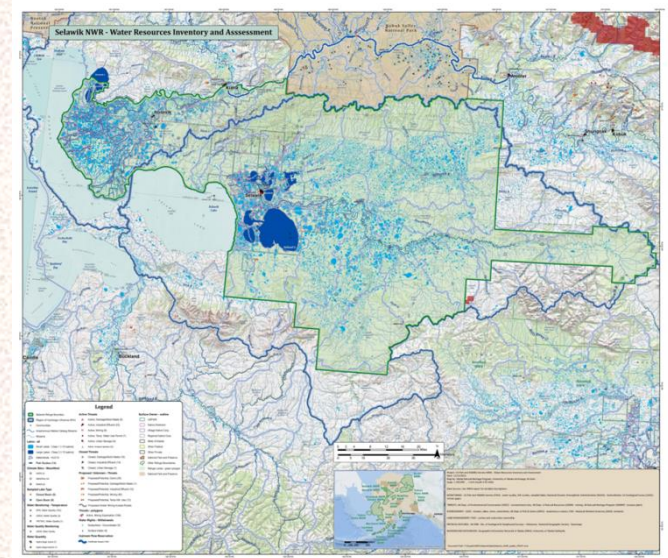
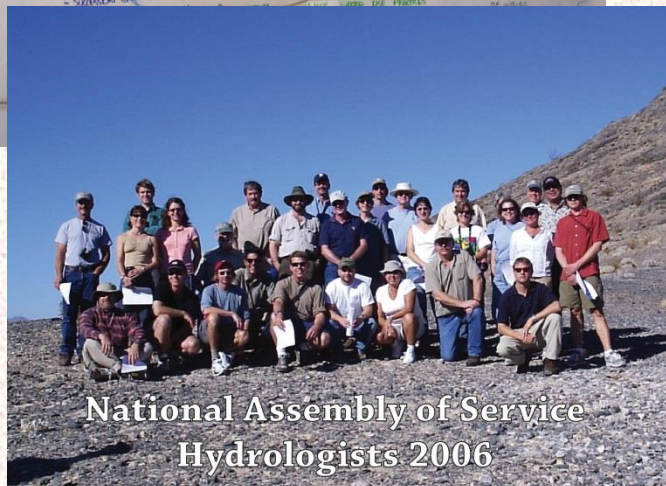
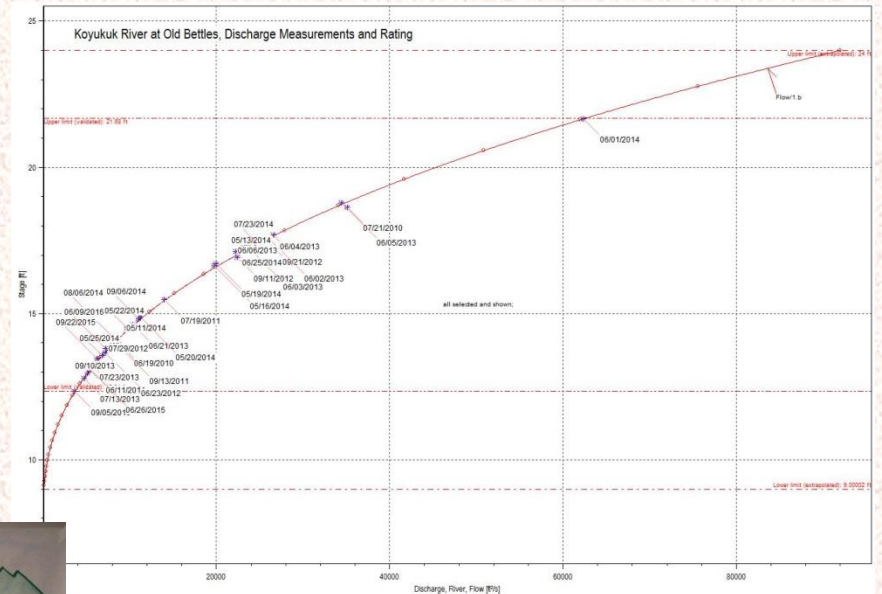
ANILCA Purposes, for all Refuges in Alaska

i. “to conserve fish and wildlife populations and habitats in their natural diversity...”

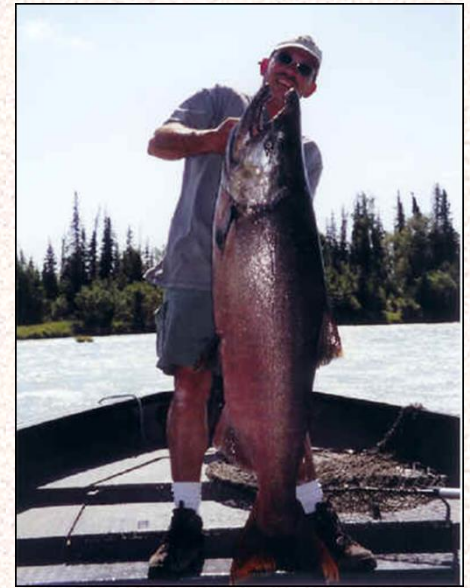
