 SUBJECT CHANGES IN 1984 FIELD PROGRAM - ARCHEOLOGICAL STUDIES

NOTES I called Sharrock to confirm discussions previously held. I advised Sharrock that archeological field work to be undertaken during the 1984 field season would include: 1) completion of systematic testing of all archeological sites within reservoir impoundment areas, dam sites, diversion tunnels, cofferdams, and the Watana spillway, and 2) reconnaissance survey of a sample of previously unsurveyed corridors for linear features (transmission lines, access roads and railroads) for the purpose of testing sensitivity models employed to date. I also advised Sharrock that archeological survey of all proposed linear features would not be completed in 1984 because of difficulties with staking actual rights-of-way. Sharrock agreed that an appropriate way to deal with cultural resources in such areas would be to include provisions for survey, evaluation, and mitigation of adverse effects into the formal mitigation plan which will be submitted to FERC. I advised Sharrock that I would be sending him a copy of the phone log of this conversation and would be asking him to indicate that it was an accurate representation of what was discussed. He agreed to sign it and return it.
