Dear Secretary Bose:

On October 27, 2015, the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (Commission) issued a letter to the Alaska Energy Authority (AEA) lifting the Integrated Licensing Process abeyance for the Susitna-Watana Hydroelectric Project. In its letter, the Commission directed AEA to file an updated Initial Study Report (ISR) roadmap and associated study reports by November 6, 2015. AEA plans to file the documents by November 6 as required by the Commission.

In addition to those documents, AEA herewith files the Susitna-Watana Hydroelectric Project Engineering Feasibility Report (EFR). The EFR provides base information for several ISR reports that will be filed this week and includes both public information and Critical Energy Infrastructure Information (filed separately). This report is being placed into the record for the information of the Commission and licensing participants. AEA is not seeking comments on this report at this time.
