### State Selection

Lands selected by the State of Alaska under the Statehood Act that have not been transferred.

### State Patented

Lands owned by the State of Alaska

### Native Allotment; Historic Place Application; Village Selection Application; Regional Selection Application; Native Group Selection

Lands chosen by natives under various sections of the Alaska Native Claims Settlement Act (ANCSA), that have not been transferred.

### Recommended to Congress pursuant to sec 17(d)2 ANCSA

Lands that were recommended for 17(d)2 classification that have not been so classified but are managed as potential wilderness areas.

### PLO 5179; PLO 5250

Lands withdrawn under section 17(d)2 of ANCSA. These lands were segregated from all forms of appropriation under public land laws and

from location and entry under the mining laws and from mineral leasing. The purpose of these withdrawals was for study as possible additions to the National Park, National Forest, Wildlife Refuge and Wild and Scenic Rivers System.

P.L.O. 5193

Withdrew lands for classification and for protection of public interest pursuant to section 17(d)1 of the Alaska Native Claims Settlement Act. The lands were segregated from all forms of appropriation and from mining laws except location for metalliferous minerals. Purpose of the withdrawal was to reserve the lands for study to determine the proper classification of the lands and to ascertain the public input values in the land which need protection.

P.L.O. 5321

Withdrew the affected lands for selection by the village corporation in the area covered by the Tanana Chiefs' Conference. This land is segregated from all forms of appropriation under the public land laws and mining laws.

P.L.O. 5418

Withdrew all unreserved public lands in Alaska, or those which may become unreserved unless specified by order at that time, for classification and protection of the public interest under section 17(d)1 of the ANCSA. The lands are withdrawn from all forms of appropriation under the public land laws and under mining laws except locations for metalliferous minerals.
