Moore Creek Halfway Cabin (IDT-031)


1 story log cabin (retains bark) with saddle notching. The wood plank roof has collapsed. Plank door frame (east orientation). 2 side windows. 3 small rusted traps still attached to roof frame. Inside: stovepipe. Outside: at least 2 pits (cache) close by cabin; some crockery (i.e. 2 bowls) several rusted barrel drums. Approximately 40-50 years east of the cabin is the remains of another cabin (?) - 1 log course, covered with plant growth, outlines a small square cabin square.
