A large and important village of the protohistoric and early historic periods, possibly predating these. There are associated graves, and semisubterranean houses are reported. The habitants of this village were closely connected by kinship and ritual, with residents of villages at Vinasale and Iditarod, and the village is considered one of the most significant of the region.
