CONFUSION ABOUT RAINY PASS R.H.
on ARC 1914 map

Dalzell (Rainy Pass R.H.)

Summit - referenced on ~~the~~ map 1915/16^{no R.H.}

Summit R.H. & Rainy Pass R.H. 4 miles above Dalzell

Relief Cabin - 1923 maps. ^{Peterson} Assume Rainy Pass Shelter Cabin,

• Reference: "Goodwin notes the relief cabin in his 1908 notes. (Other)

• 1939 ARC map identifies Rainy Pass R.H.

(Rainy Pass R.H., Pass Creek R.H., Pass Creek Cabin)

• Location on ^{inventory} form, but from what reference?

Rainy Pass R.H. (Hynzel p. 21) "described in the same vicinity as Pass Creek R.H. (Read-McNelly, 1923; Reduzell, and ARC map 1916)". Same structure?

Pass Creek R.H. (Hynzel p. 22) "low-level level reconnaissance on Pass Creek approx 2/3 mile south of Rainy Pass Lake. Found ruin - inconsistent description from Read (1965)"
