Friday 4 - Airplane south bound 4:15 o'clock, right down over the river in a blinding snowstorm. How do they get away with it.

Saturday 5 - One inch of snow this morning. To the Five Mile with dogs. Caribou on the bar again. Cloudy.

Sunday 6 - Fixed the 5-mile dugway. Saw a moose. Snowing this evening.

Monday 7 - Cutting wood. Spitting snow all day.

Tuesday 8 - Out to Seven Mile Cr. with the dogs. Snow on the ground.

Wednesday 9 - Up Tin Cr. with the dogs. Saw a red fox.

Thursday 10 - Up to the high lakes. Saw a moose. South wind, warm. Snow nearly gone.

Friday 11 - Out to the five mile point cutting some wood, etc. South wind, warm.

Saturday 12 - Out past the 7-mile lake. Saw some moose and caribou tracks. Spitting snow all day.

Sunday 13 - Cutting and hauling wood. Ice running in the slough. Temperature 10.

Wednesday 16 - Out past the 7-mile Lake with the dogs. Lakes carry (their weight on ice). 8" of new snow.

Thursday 17 - Boiling the shirt, etc. Six below this morning.

Friday 18 - Carved my face (shaved). Did not make much of an improvement. Snowing.

Saturday 19 - Went to Peluk. Heavy trail.

Sunday 20 - Went to Sullivan and back to Peluk. Heavy trail. 20° below this morning.

Monday 21 - Back to Hells Gate. Very strong Chinook blowing this evening.

Tuesday 22 - Cut some wood. Strong Chinook. Snow going fast.

Wednesday 23 - Chinook still blowing, 46 above. Snow all gone on the flats. Trail shot to hell again.

Thursday 24 - Doing nothing particular. Wind north, 28° above, lakes no good.
