

DESCRIPTION OF TATINA AVIATION FIELD RESERVE

A piece or parcel of land situated in Latitude 62°19 North, Longitude 153°23 West, Fourth Judicial Division, Territory of Alaska, more particularly described as follows: From a stake at the point of Land at the confluence of Tatina River and South Fork of Kuskokwim River thence Due South a distance of 760 feet to Corner No. 1 or point of beginning. This Cor. No. 1 also bears S. 15°06' E. a distance of 302 feet from a stake midway on the east or front end of Einar Carlsons 12x14 log cabin; thence S. 65°35' E. a distance of 1795 feet to Cor. No. 2, thence N. 85°00' E. a distance of 3803 1/2 feet to Cor. No. 3, thence S. 5°00' E. a distance of 500 feet to Cor. No. 4, thence S. 39°20 1/2' W. a distance of 1474 1/2 feet to Cor. No. 5, thence S. 24°25' W. a distance of 500 feet to Cor. No. 6, thence N. 65°35' W. a distance of 3050 feet to Cor. No. 7, thence S. 85°00' W. a distance of 1730 feet to Cor. No. 8, thence N. 5°00' W. a distance of 500 feet to Cor. No. 9, thence N. 1°35' E. a distance of 441 1/2 feet to Cor. No. 10, thence N. 24°25' E. a distance of 500 feet to Cor. No. 1 the place of beginning. Said piece or parcel of land lying within the above described 10 boundaries containing 149 1/2 Acres more or less, all of which is Public Domain.
