Tatina River

from form 'Information on Aircraft Landing Facility'

--shelter cabin (incomplete) in timber at west end of field
--the map shows "CCC cabin" as well as Einar Larson cabin
--under 'other info' says there is "a small cabin, built by a trapper",...."and a shelter cabin is being constructed in the timber north of the west end of the constructed field"
dated November 30th 1939

Nov 16, 1938

to Ike Taylor, Chief engineer in Juneau---from M.C. Edmonds, sup't

--CCC work on two airfields in Rainey Pass area; at Rhone R. and emergency only at Stillman lake

--also plans to build shelter cabins at each if good logs available

14Jul38

to Edmonds from Taylor

"It now appears doubtful that we will get any money for airfield construction. If this field is built, it will probably have to be done by the CCC."

28Nov39

to Taylor from Edmonds

--CCC forces working on this field returned to town a few days ago
