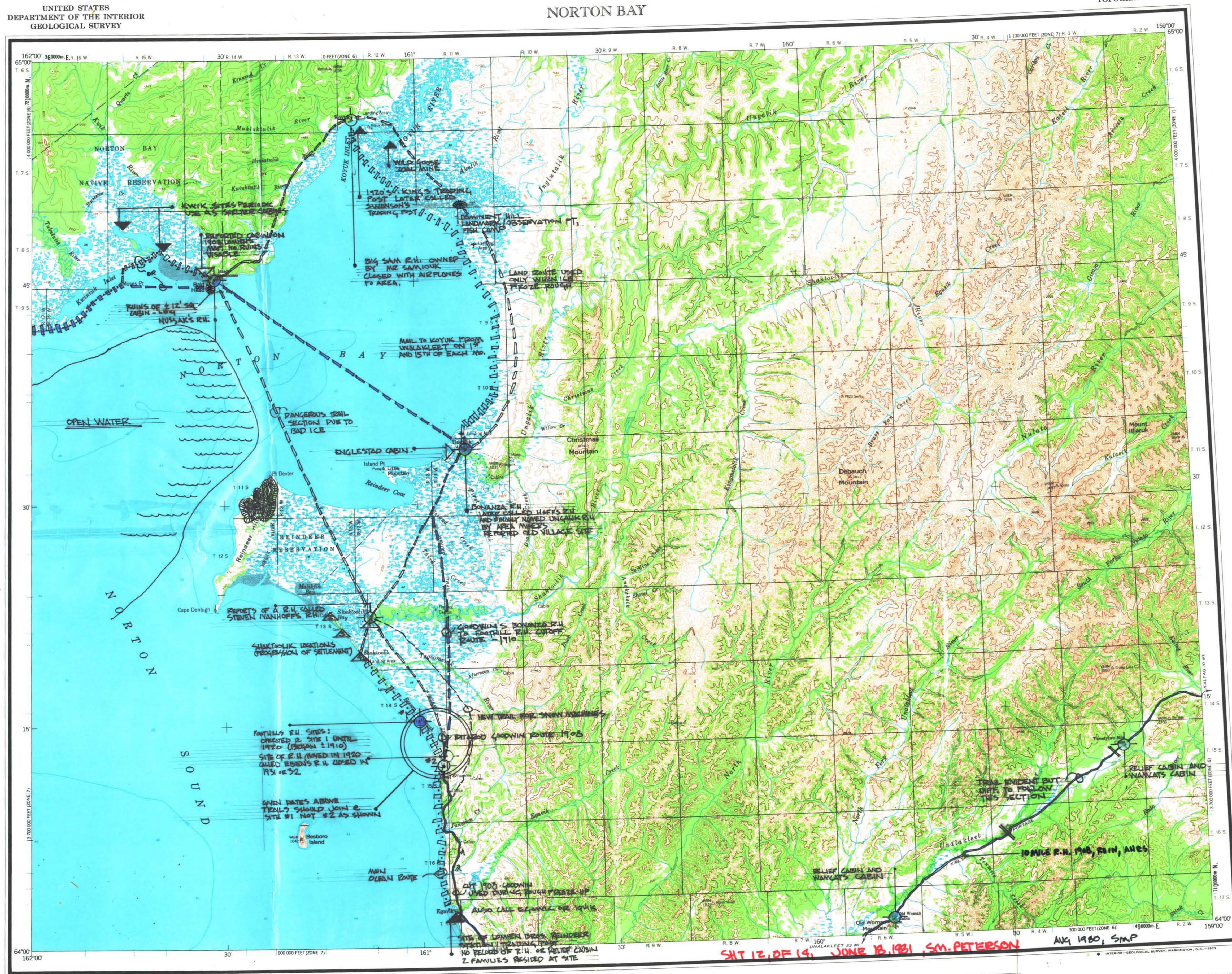

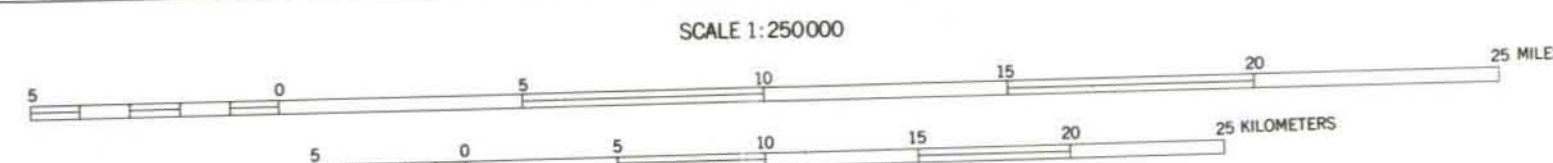

FOLIOS K-12, K-13, AND K-17, KATEEL RIVER MERIDIAN

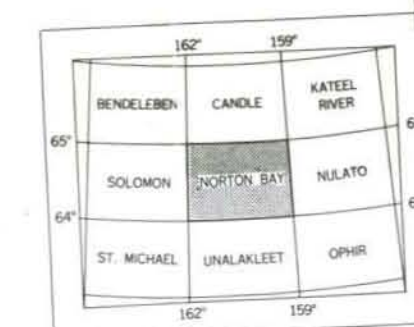
