STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE:

Ten-Mile Cabin is nationally significant because of its association with the Iditarod National Historic Trail. The cabin is located at the mouth of the Ten-Mile River where it empties into the Unalakleet River. Ten-Mile Cabin served as a relief cabin and WAMCATS maintenance station between the Old Woman Roadhouse and Twenty-Two Mile Cabin. Little remains of the existing structure.
