STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE:

1946. Same as "Jimmy the Greek" R.H. of 1916, served as a Roadhouse and Relief Cabin for the Alaska Road Commission. The Ipankee Creek Site was purchased by the Alaska Road Commission in 1925. A Barn was built at the site in 1926.
