Remains of several structures are present at the site however all are in a ruin condition with only foundation logs showing.

Tolstoi, served as a river head supply point for much of the mining activities in the area. From 1916 to 1918 a Post office was located there. It appears to have been a sizable river settlement in support of the gold mining activities on Westwood Creek.
