HISTORIC SIGNIFICANCE

Constructed camp 1905-06.
 Orth: Local name for a station on ARR reported in 1909 as "Tunnel Siding" by Grant and Missins (1913, p. 1), USGS. The AER guide of 1922 lists the station as "Tunnel". A post office was established here in 1930, but discontinued in 1931. The name of the station was derived from the two RR tunnels in the vicinity.
