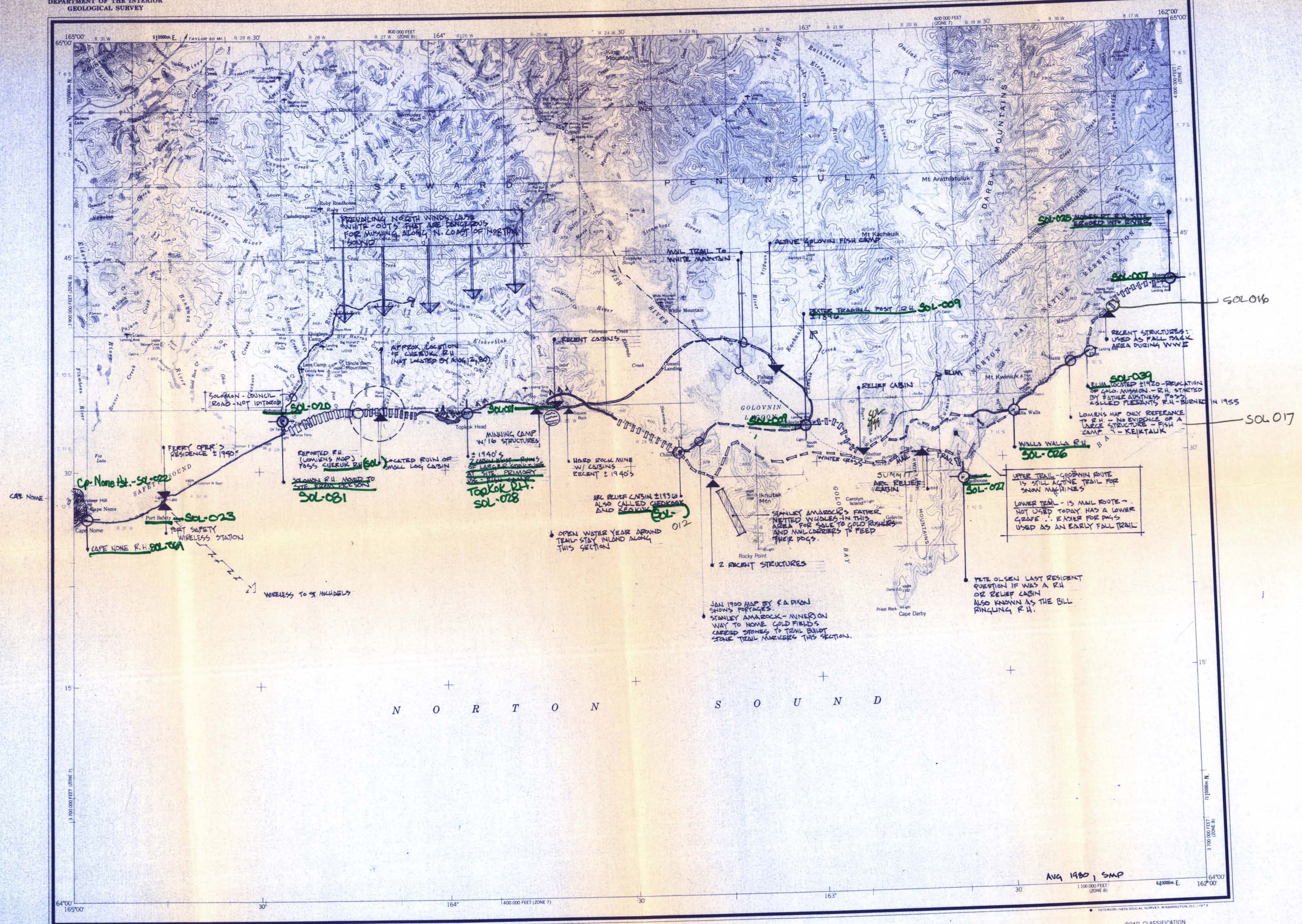

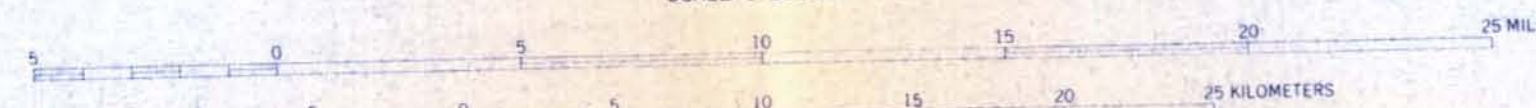

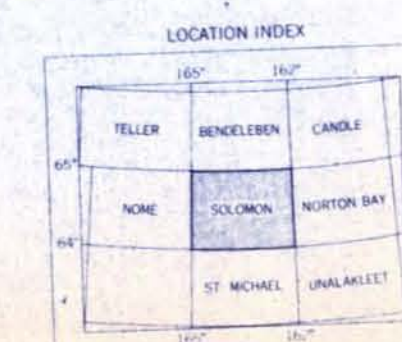
1955 MAGNETIC DECLINATION AT SOUTH EDGE OF SHEET VARIES FROM 17°30' TO 19°30' EAST
