8. Bluff - AHRS No. SOL-021 - National Significance

Bluff is nationally significant because if its association with the Iditarod National Historic Trail. It is also nationally significant because of different mining technologies exhibited at the site, i.e., dredging, mining, drag line, cat and striping and hydraulic mining operation. The remains structures are found at the site and include the remains of the Bluff house, a bonya, a small store, a post office, and several structures that used as shops. The site remains relatively intact and rich artifactual mains. A ship wreck is also located near the site.
