



Fines and Fees

Overdue Fines

- Fines accrue at \$.25 (twenty-five cents) per day, per overdue item.
- When a patron has incurred \$5.00 in fines, the library suspends borrowing privileges until fines are paid, and the item is returned or a replacement fee has been paid.
- If a book is placed in a book drop when the library is closed, fines will continue to accrue until the library is open and the book can be checked in.
- Fines may be paid at the UAA/APU Consortium Library circulation desk with cash, check or credit card (Visa or MasterCard only).

Lost Items

- The replacement charge for a lost book is \$75.00 plus any outstanding fines.
- ARLIS may on a case-by-case basis accept replacement copies for lost books.

Damaged Items

- Fees may be charged for damaged items:
 - \$10 – tag replacement
 - \$24 – minimum repair
 - \$40 – rebinding
 - \$75 – replacement

Furs, Mounts and Skulls Collection

- Repair or replacement due to loss or damage, including failure to return the item, will be charged at the current market price as determined by the ARLIS Management Team.
- A \$10 fine may be charged for each tag that is damaged or removed.
