The collection entitled *Alaska Department of Fish and Game Historical Photographs, 1950-1991* is comprised of eight boxes of photographs and is housed at Alaska Resources Library and Information Services (ARLIS) in Anchorage, Alaska. ARLIS is Alaska Department of Fish and Game's library, providing library services statewide to the Department.

Approximately 600 selected photographs were added to the *Alaska Digital Archives* (<http://vilda.alaska.edu/>) in 2017. Most were selected to feature the historical operations of ADF&G in both the fisheries and wildlife realms.
